## **THE DuPONT MUSEUM LOCATED IN DuPONT, WASHINGTON**

The Museum tells the story of the unique role that DuPont played in the development of Washington State and the Puget Sound Region. Exhibits include displays and artifacts from the four eras of DuPont history; beginning with the Native Americans through the Hudson Bay Company and DuPont Company to Weyerhaeuser's planned community of Northwest Landing. The Museum features archival photos, tools used to manufacture dynamite and showcases Life in a Company Town 1906 to today.

The DuPont Museum is located at 207 Barksdale Avenue, DuPont, Washington, just off I-5, exit 119. Parking is available at the Museum. The Museum is open Wednesday through Friday and Sunday 1-4pm.

For additional activities, the City of DuPont boasts over 12 miles of designated trails, 50 acres of developed parks, 500 acres of open space and natural areas, and the DuPont Historic Village
